



Plant Janitorial/Utility Belgium, WI

GENERAL SUMMARY:

Responsible for cleaning and janitorial duties in the plant and plant offices as well as general maintenance and upkeep on buildings and grounds.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for all janitorial duties and garbage removal in the following:
 - Plant restrooms
 - Plant break room
 - Office area
 - Office restrooms
 - Outside break area
 - Parking lot
- Responsible for general housekeeping in the plant.
- Assists/responsible for general maintenance duties in the plant as assigned by the Maintenance Supervisors or Operations Manager.
- Performs painting duties as needed.
- Responsible for facility lawn care during summer months.
- Will be asked to drive and retrieve maintenance parts as needed.
- Responsible for the transporting of our weekly production samples to the corporate office in Manitowoc.
- Needs to perform tasks and document completion on Housekeeping Checklist.
- Needs to perform tasks and document completion on the Master Sanitation Checklist
- May perform other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Supervisors and Operations Manager.
- Adhere to all Lakeside Foods policies and procedures.
- Notify supervisor or manager immediately if any unsafe, unhealthy, or potentially hazardous conditions are discovered.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

Knowledge:

- Six months to one year of related experience and/or training.

Language Skills:

- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions and procedure manuals.
- Ability to write routine reports.

Mathematical Skills:

- Ability to perform basic mathematics. Including decimals and percentages.

Reasoning Ability:

- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral or diagram form.
- Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.
