



Technician A – Manitowoc, WI

GENERAL SUMMARY:

Responsible for repairing and maintaining the electrical portion of the equipment in an operational and safe condition for production. Duties will not be limited to electrical only and will include mechanical as well.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Pass a A-Tech written and practical exam (No time limit).
- Maintain a 90% completion on assigned PM's.
- Repair and maintain the electrical operation of machines.
- Tear down and set up fillers, kettles, and other equipment needed for the daily operation of the lines.
- Perform clean-up duties as directed to insure contamination free products.
- Be able to write, monitor and troubleshoot complex PLC programs.
- Troubleshoot and repair printers, metal detectors, scales, and Vision systems, etc.
- Assist mechanics when necessary for line repair.
- Be able to read and draw electrical blue prints and schematics.
- Be familiar with the NEC.
- May be assigned other duties as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

Knowledge:

- High school graduate or equivalence and related vo-tech or five years work experience preferred.
- Must be able to pass a A-Tech exam and practical test.
- Must keep a 90% completion average on PM's.
- Must work in a safe manner to himself and others.
- Must be able to work with a little supervision.
- Must have a basic understanding of machine and line operation and of requirements for an acceptable product.
- Must have competent troubleshooting techniques.
- Must be able to write effective problem solving programs.

Language Skills:

- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals.

Reasoning Ability:

- Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of variables in situations where only limited standardization exists.
- Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

TEAMWORK AT LAKESIDE (TAL):

- Through individual and team efforts, enthusiastically work toward the continuous improvement of his/her job, work area, department and Lakeside as a whole. Fully participate in TAL by "living" Lakeside's Standards of Conduct and being an active member of operational and project teams. By action and work, clearly and visibly demonstrate the spirit of teamwork, cooperation and respect for others in all business transactions and exchanges.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Standing – must be able to stand entire shift
- Walking - Walks periodically to get parts and materials
- Sitting – Limited sitting required
- Lifting – Able to regularly lift up to 25 pounds; lift up to 100 pounds on an occasional basis during a repair
- Carrying – Must be able to carry up to 75 lbs. for 100 ft.
- Pulling – Able to pull items of 200 lbs. occasionally
- Climbing – Must occasionally climb or balance and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands and fingers to handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls, and reach with hands and arms.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- Mainly outdoor work during the summer and fall. Indoors during the winter and spring
- Could be work either first or second shift
- Weekend work during the harvest season
- Must keep self and tools in clean condition

SAFETY:

- Follow all safety policies and procedures.
- Report all injuries within 24 hours.
- Report all unsafe conditions and unsafe acts to the supervisor immediately.
- Take an active roll in the daily safety and participate in the plant safety committee.
- Data to be tracked by supervisors and submitted to management.
- Set positive example by wearing PPE and following all safety policies.
- Complete the incident analysis form including the cause and possible preventions within 24 hours.
- Enforce all safety policies and inform management of all employee safety discrepancies.
- Safety training of all new seasonal and full time employees
- Data to tracked by HR department and submitted to upper management
